Veterans Service Beyond Our Walls: The Blinded Veterans Association (BVA) came into existence shortly after WWII. It was important in encouraging the government to establish the first Blind Rehabilitation Center at Hines VA in Illinois. Blind rehabilitation is necessary not only for war injuries but also for treatment of impaired vision due to a myriad of diseases. The BVA serves as an advocate for programs in lobbying congress as for the individual veteran who is seeking service connected disability. Recent war injuries have increased the need for services with Traumatic Brain Injuries (TBI) leading to accompanying vision deficits. In one study of 46 combat veterans, the blast injury itself led to 43% receiving eye injury without penetrating wounds. In addition, many TBI patients have accompanying hearing loss. The BVA has for over sixty years been advocating for the veteran as they come home from war with enduring visual impairments. Please make checks out to "UUSG" and write "BOW-BVA" in the memo line.
